## **Town of Saugerties** Conservation Advisory Commission

Meeting minutes for July 17th, 2008

- This meeting was the first in a series with the Open Space Plan contractor Behan Associates. Melissa Barry from Behan led the meeting.
- A date was set for the driving tour of the Town on August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at 9:00. The alternate date is the 13<sup>th</sup>. Miles Putnam will go on the tour to provide information.
- Melissa gave an overview of the work plan and the schedule. She stated that there is a need to identify stakeholders and to form focus groups.
- There will be a visioning workshop in September for public outreach.
  - Publicity will be via newspapers, radio, cable TV and the Town website.
  - The focus groups will go through important features of the Town by category (e.g. trails, natural resources).
- A brainstorming session was held to help define terms within the plan. These included:
  - Definition of open space,
  - Guidelines/principles for developing the plan,
    - Discussion of what is meant by a "sense of place"
    - Cognitive mapping (developed by Kevin Lynch) refers to nodes, districts, paths, edges and landmarks
  - Plan themes were discussed (water, historic, recreation, agriculture, wildlife protection)
- There was some misunderstanding regarding the responsible party for development of the questionnaire. The CAC group will develop it.
  - J. Randall provided some questions that were reviewed by S. Barbour and E. Shafer.
  - L. Thornton provided copies of the questions to Behan and also a copy for G. Marzec to keep on file.
- Melissa Barry asked for an e-mail list for CAC members. G. Marzec will provide this to her.
- L. Thornton asked that we review the contract with Behan and provided copies for all.
- Subsequent to the meeting, M. Barry will provide a summary of the discussions via email.
- The next meeting is on August 21st, 2008 at 7:00 pm.
